

Tim Hortons Cheat Sheet

- ✓ CFIA approved, UL certified GREEN products, GRA certified Restaurant SAFE
- ✓ SDS sheets and data usage available at – www.scitechinc.ca
- ✓ Glove usage is always recommended - safety first
- ✓ Rinse or wipe down with water after cleaning with all chemical products

PROTOCOL K-300i – Cleaner & Degreaser

- K-300i is a concentrated product and **MUST BE DILUTED** with water to be effective
- Product best administered through a spray bottle
- Using provided calibrated pump:
 - 1 pump into a 1 litre bottle + fill the rest with water = everyday use
 - 2 pumps into a 1 litre bottle + fill the rest with water = medium soils
 - 3 pumps into a 1 litre bottle + fill the rest with water = tough stains

Must be diluted with water to work

PROTOCOL K-650 – Calcium, Rust & Lime Remover

- Best used undiluted, however may be diluted with water at 1:2
- Effectively removes calcium, lime & rust deposits
- Excellent on stone surfaces and anywhere water is present.

Rinse all surfaces with water after using 

Sidewalk stains	Iced cappuccino machines
Urinals	Textured kitchen tile floor
Kitchen shelving	Grout on bathroom walls & floors
Tea pots & baskets	Rust: DT signs, fridge, handles, taps etc.
Freezer base	Exterior brick on building (calcium)
Mop sink & pails
